Celebrate Recovery Group Here At FMC

Celebrate Recovery is a program to help overcome hurts, habits, and hang-ups. What is a hurt, habit, or hang-up? A hurt, habit, or hang-up is anything that hinders your walk with God.

The feeling of being **HURT is an emotional reaction** to another person's behavior or to a disturbing situation. A **HABIT is an addiction** to someone or something.

HANG-UPS are **negative mental attitudes** that are used to cope with people or adversity.

Jesus wants to set you free from hurts, habits, and hang-ups.

The Spirit of the Lord [is] upon Me, because He has anointed Me [the Anointed One, the Messiah] to preach the good news (the Gospel) to the poor; He has sent Me to announce release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to send forth as delivered those who are oppressed [who are downtrodden, bruised, crushed, and broken down by calamity].
