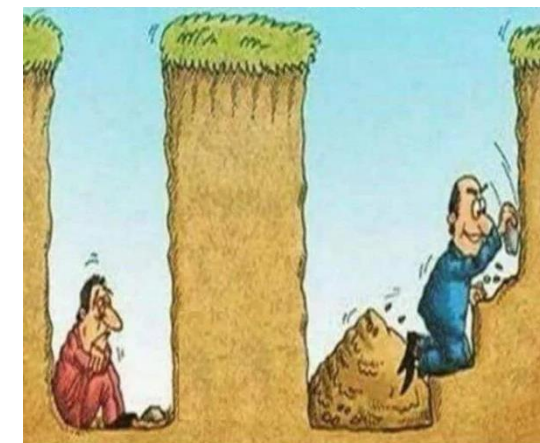
Let There Be Light
