Palm Sunday - A Good Day to Declare our Faith

Sometimes we as people of faith people are misunderstood when we speak of our needs as though we already received the answer, while the need is still staring us in the face. We base this kind of faith confession on the second part of Romans 4:17 which says: **God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did.**

Then the verses following show Abraham's faith worked the same way.

If faith worked for Abraham, it will work for us too, because God shows no partiality. (Acts 10:34)

On Palm Sunday Jesus allowed His followers to call him KING even though He was not yet on His throne. In fact, He was actually on a donkey which could be considered the opposite of a throne.

The bottom line here is if we know God's will on something, it's good to go ahead and speak in faith according to what is sure to happen.

Facts to count on:

God said He would send the Messiah (Jesus). He did.

Jesus said He would die for us. He did.

Jesus said He would rise the third day. He did.

Jesus said He would ascend to heaven. He did.

Jesus said He will return to earth. He will.

Jesus said He would meet our every need if we put Him first in our lives. He does. (When we do.) (Matthew 6:33)

The Bible is filled with promises to God's people. Prayers spoken in faith before they are manifested will be answered in His timing. **If God Said He Would, He Will!**

Jesus told us to have faith in God and that whoever believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. (Mark 11:22-23)
